

Day 2 Group Activity: After reviewing the video exemplar, work with your teammates to develop a resource that can be *applied* in various areas of nursing practice, education, regulation, and/or policy development to promote Professional Identity in Nursing.

Group Activity Three-step process:

Step 1: All attendees (1130-1150): View video exemplar three times to gain initial impressions and consider ways that the exemplar might be applied in various areas of nursing practice, education, regulation, and policy development to promote Professional Identity in Nursing.

Step 2: All attendees (1150-1220): Brainstorming and dialogue session. Gather in assigned break-out rooms (4 groups of 12 members). Brainstorm and draft a list of 3-5 potential resources that might be developed to promote PIN. Then, select 2 examples from the list of potential resources, and assign 1 example to each of the 2 sub-groups for resource development.

Step 3: Assemble in assigned break-out rooms (1235-1335): 8 groups of 6 members to develop a resource that can be *applied* in various areas of nursing practice, education, regulation, and/or policy development to promote Professional Identity in Nursing. Deliverable: create the resource and enter your information into the Group Activity Form. Select a spokesperson to report to the full group.

1335-1415 All Attendees: Reconvene as a large group in the general area. Spokesperson for each group shares resource. Each group has **4 minutes** to highlight their application.
